

Statement from CUPW on the Federal NDP's Climate Plan

"The Canadian Union of Postal Workers applauds the federal New Democratic Party's plans for a greener Canada Post, as we need concrete solutions to the biggest fight of our lifetime.

For many years, we have advocated that Canada Post can and should play a key role in addressing its own ecological footprint and leading the way for the large-scale changes required. Our *Delivering Community Power* campaign outlines how we can make this happen: a made-in-Canada electric fleet, electric vehicle charging stations at post offices across the country, and retrofitting public buildings to make them greener.
