140317-66 CANADA POST — ELIMINATING DOOR-TO-DOOR MAIL DELIVERY

WHEREAS Canada Post announced on December 11, 2013 its plan to replace door-to-door delivery with community mail boxes;

WHEREAS door-to-door delivery is a service that benefits citizens;

WHEREAS there was very little consultation on this important proposed change to door-to-door delivery;

It is moved:

1. That the City of Boucherville advise the Minister of Transportation, Ms. Lisa Raitt, that it wants to maintain door-to-door delivery and, therefore, calls for a moratorium on the

proposed changes;

- 2. That the City of Boucherville asks the federal government to consult with the public on the type of postal service they need before allowing CANADA POST to implement major changes to the public postal service.
- 3. That a copy of this resolution be sent to the president of the CANADIAN UNION OF POSTAL WORKERS, to the Member of Parliament and to the president of the FEDERATION OF CANADIAN MUNICIPALITIES.
