INVENTOR AND POLITICIAN
HUBBARD INVENTED AND PATENTED A COMMERCIAL
BAKER'S OVEN, THE HUBBARD PORTABLE. IN 1894,
HE BECAME THE FIRST BLACK COUNCILLOR IN ANY
MAJOR CANADIAN CITY WHEN HE WAS ELECTED
ALDERMAN IN TORONTO. HE ALSO CO-FOUNDED
THE FIRST PUBLICLY OWNED HYDROELECTRIC
COMPANY IN ONTARIO.
