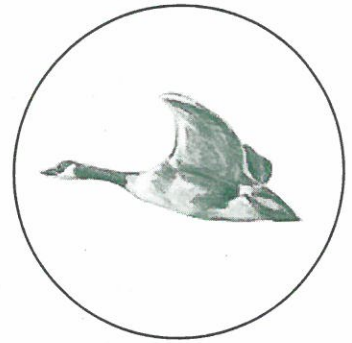

WHEREAS recent and ongoing changes are being made by Canada Post that effect small rural communities, like, drastic postage rate hikes, closing or downsizing Local Post Offices, loss of jobs;

AND WHEREAS Canada Post did not properly consult on these changes, effectively eliminating any opportunity for input from the people who will be most affected;

AND WHEREAS Canada Post offers a public service that needs to be protected;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the RM of Coldwell send this resolution of support to the Minister responsible for Canada Post that calls on the government to reverse the changes to services announced by Canada Post, and to look instead for ways to increase service and revenues in areas such as postal banking;

AND FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that the RM of Coldwell ask the Federation of Canadian Municipalities to request that the federal government consult with the public about what kind of postal service they need before allowing Canada Post to make such major changes to public postal service.
