The Union's delegation will participate in May Day events, meet with Cuban postal workers, visit post offices and plants, participate in an International Solidarity conference, as well participate in cultural activities in order to gain a better understanding of the current situation in Cuba.

The AISF will be responsible for all delegate costs associated with airfare, accommodations, per diems, May Day activities, travel while in Cuba, and interpretation services. <u>Selected applicants will be responsible for any additional costs</u>, as well as for securing their leave from their employer and all lost wages.

All travel and accommodation arrangements will be made by the Union.
