Light Beam Ceremony on Mount Royal: City of Montreal, Comité Mémoire and Polytechnique Montréal

We remember the 14 young women whose lives were cut short on December 6, 1989.

In order to keep the memory alive of the 14 women who lost their lives in the anti-feminist attack of December 6, 1989, the City of Montreal, in collaboration with the Comité Mémoire light up the Montreal sky. At 5:10 p.m., the time when the first shots were fired, light beams will illuminate the sky one at a time, every few seconds, as the names of the 14 victims are called.
