**REQUEST FOR SUPPORT FROM THE  
HAUTES-LAURENTIDES LOCAL OF THE  
CANADIAN UNION OF POSTAL WORKERS**

WHEREAS Canada Post announced on December 11, 2013 that it plans to convert all door-to-door delivery to community mailbox (CMB) delivery;

WHEREAS 6,000 to 8,000 postal jobs will be destroyed and five million households will lose door-to-door delivery over the next five years;

WHEREAS Canada Post offers a public service that needs to be protected;

WHEREAS these cuts will hurt seniors and people with disabilities in particular;

CONSEQUENTLY:

It is moved by Councillor Lise St-Louis and seconded by Councillor Jocelyne Cloutier that the municipality of Mont-Laurier write a letter to Lisa Raitt, Minister responsible for Canada Post, that calls on the government to reverse the changes to services announced by Canada Post, and to look instead for ways to increase service and revenues in areas such as postal banking;

That, additionally, calls on the parties to resume discussions with a view to finding new, compromise solutions that will not affect the public so directly; and

That a copy of this resolution be sent to Marc-André Morin, MP for Laurentides-Labelle; Claude Dauphine, president of the Federation of Canadian Municipalities; Denis Lemelin, National President of the Canadian Union of Postal Workers; and Nancy Roussel, President of the Hautes-Laurentides Local of CUPW.
