At one of its recent meetings, the CUPW National Executive Board adopted the following resolution:

“BE IT RESOLVED that CUPW send a six-person delegation to the CISO Symposium, which will be held in Montreal on November 29 & 30, and December 1st, 2018.”

This conference is organized by the *Centre international de solidarité ouvrière* (CISO) (International Centre for Worker Solidarity), a vital forum where Quebec unions come together to focus on issues of international solidarity, particularly with a view to sharing resources and exchanging alternative information.

Delegates will be selected based on the following criteria:

Applicants must have demonstrated commitment to the Union.

On returning, the participants will be required to write a 300 to 500-words report on their experiences at the conference.
