I was distressed to read accounts yesterday of proposals by Canada Post to implement massive cuts to the Canadian postal network in the next five years. It is clear that the proposed cuts in door-to-door delivery, the onerous new pricing schedule and other proposals will have a tremendous negative impact on your members and millions of Canadians who rely on Canada Post every day.

I take the opportunity to reiterate UNI Post and Logistics' ongoing support for robust, universal postal services.
